PIIC and The Penn Literacy Network of the University of Pennsylvania are offering a graduate level, continuing education course for school leaders in participating PIIC Intermediate Units. The course will be piloted at Appalachia IU 8 beginning this month. A second round of courses will be offered at PIIC PD summer and fall events.

As the course description describes, "PLN 1 for School Leaders integrates leadership standards, change theories, and literacy strategies to increase student engagement which leads to student achievement. Dr. Brian Toth, Superintendent of the Bellwood-Antis School District and Dr. Thomas Otto, Director of Curriculum at Bellwood Antis School District will be instructing the course, which consists of 4 face-to face, day-long sessions and one online class. Participants of the course will earn 4.5 continuing education, graduate level credits and 60 (sixty) Act 45 hours.
